

## Student of the Month

The Nursing Lab is a special place, where RN students can go and practice their skills. The lab is located in C004/C008, in the basement level of the classroom building. The Lab has a variety of teaching tools which can greatly help RN students to hone their clinical skills.

The Nursing Lab contains state of the art mannequins that are able to simulate a variety of diseases and medical conditions. The mannequins are very lifelike, and can be programmed to bleed, breath, and interact with the student as a real patient would. One of the mannequins is able to simulate childbirth!

RN students can spend as much or as little time in the Nursing
